From Practice Certification

Example: Insurance Company – Combining learning & certification in one platform

Formative:

- Includes **practice tests** and **self-assessments** with instant, adaptive feedback to identify knowledge gaps.

Summative:

- Once the learning path is completed, advisors take a **secure, certified exam** on the same platform to validate their knowledge.
- Exams can be taken online with or without remote proctoring, depending on internal compliance requirements.

Outcome:

- A **seamless experience** from training to certification.
- **Time-saving and consistent process** for the L&D team: all assessments managed in one platform.

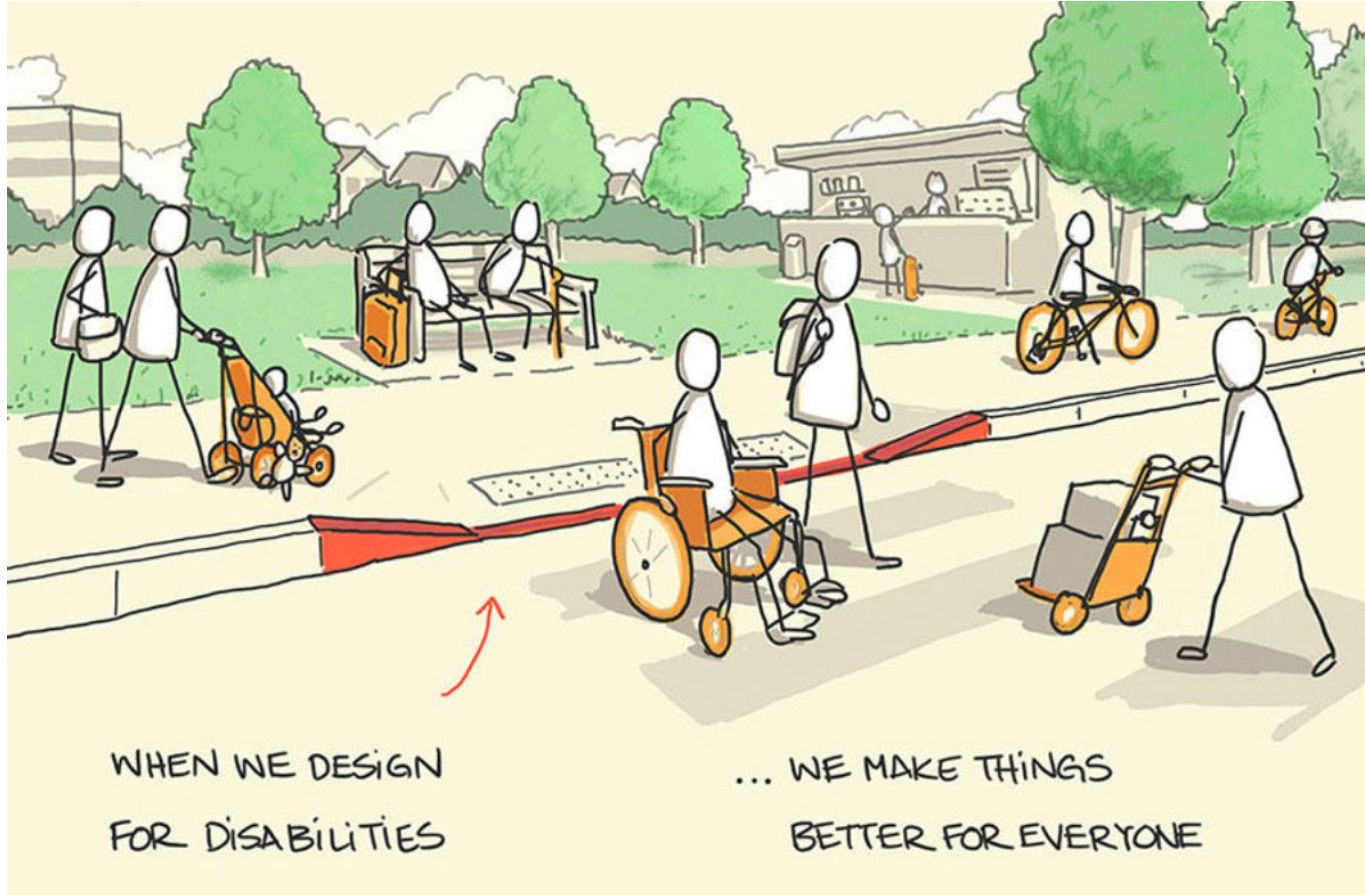
